- In 1972 staff drove 11,800 miles to care for patients...in 2019 that number was 619,713
- In 1972 a total of 390 visits were made to provide skilled nursing care...today that number is well over 35,000 visits
- In 1975 charitable giving levels for the annual fund were \$1, \$5 and \$10...and a \$100 donation made you a "life member"
