Personal Care Services

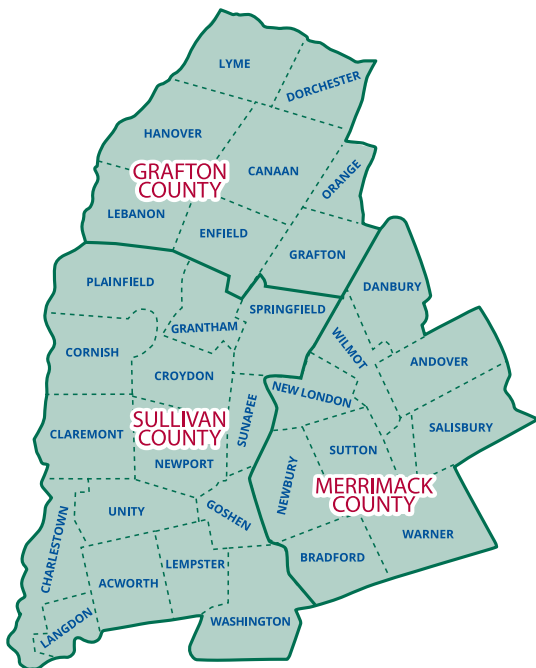
- Hands-on care such as bathing, dressing, grooming
